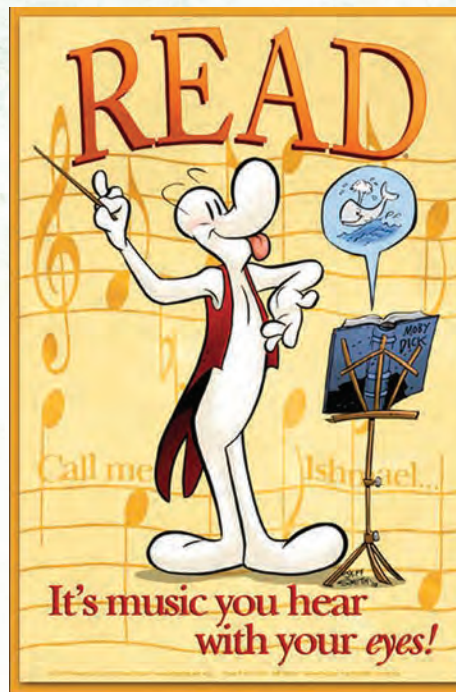


L'ÂME D'IMAGINAIRE

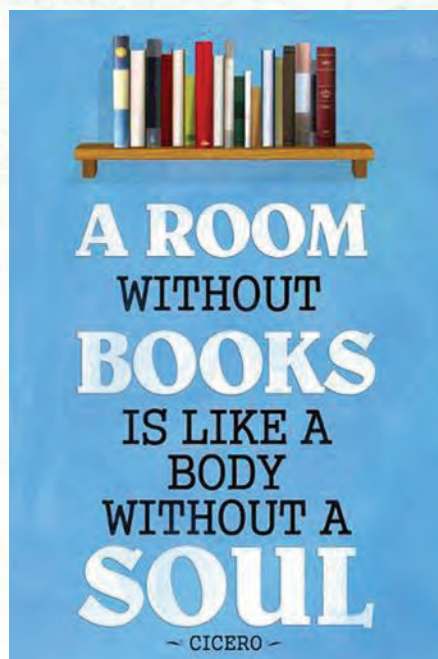

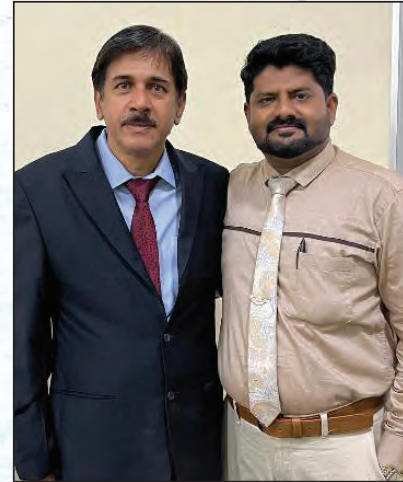

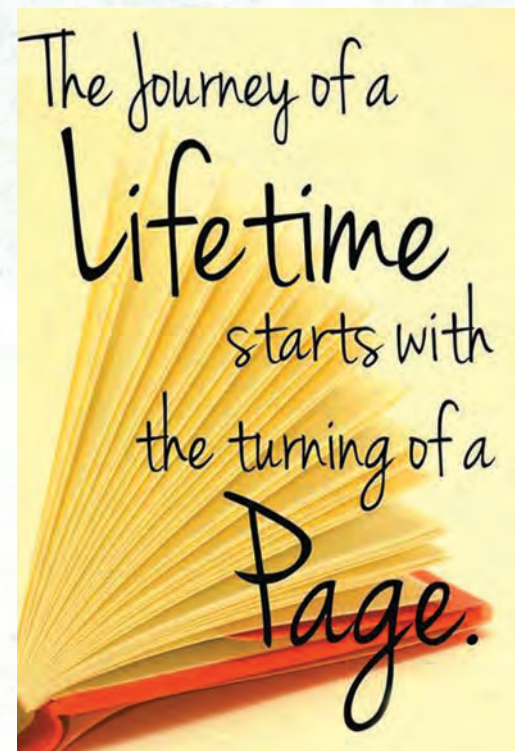




TABLE TENNIS CHAMPIONSHIP - INAUGURAL FUNCTION

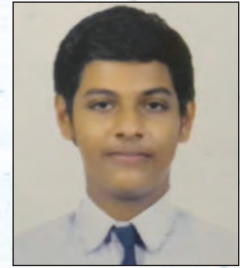

THE LINKS OF THE FABRIC

Nature provides many marvels to ponder and wonder. But that nature rests upon a vast four-dimensional fabric called space – Time. Out of the four, the three dimensions are length, breath and height and the fourth dimension is time. Together they make up our universe's structure, past, present and future. This idea of the fabric of space time was created by Hermann Minkowski who explained Einstein's theory of relativity through this concept. Imagine a fabric which is stretched, what happens if we put a mass on it? The fabric bends. Likewise, the fabric of space time also bends when matter is placed in it. At the point of bending or curvature of space-time a force is generated which is known as gravity. We all know gravity determines trajectory, position and motion of matter in space-time and thus matter determines the curvature of space-time. Again, let us imagine that piece of cloth, if we keep on adding mass at a very particular point in that fabric, due to heavy density the fabric tears and a hole is created similarly. If a star of high mass collapses under its own gravity, it creates a singularity which is a hole in space time This explanation is to explain the links between this fabric of space time. We all think that the shortest distance between these points is by a straight line connecting these points, but the shortest distance between them is created if we fold the fabric of space time in such a way that these two points exactly overlap on each other and this folding can be done by matter density and gravity. Now we know that a singularity which is a hole through space-time is created at a point of extreme mass density approximately equal to infinity. If we imagine at these two points singularities are created that is two holes are created by bending the space time enough to break them then a tunnel like structure is formed through these holes through which we can travel billions of miles greater than the speed of light. This tunnel is called a wormhole, physicists think that wormholes are the manifestation of two black holes connected together. Wormholes are actually possible by Einstein's theory of relativity but only if we have negative mass which is needed to stabilize it. Negative mass is not yet discovered therefore the existence of wormholes is a real mystery for the scientific community. But its discovery will create shockwaves in physics. For all we know if there are wormholes, we will never be late to a particular place and we can explore the endless universe, go to places that cannot be reached, even jump from one universe to another, even control forces of nature and even far beyond our imagination. I really hope wormholes exist. These are the links of the fabric.

You might have learnt from other sources the tests of divisibility by 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 9 and 10. In this article, I give a method for divisibility by 7.

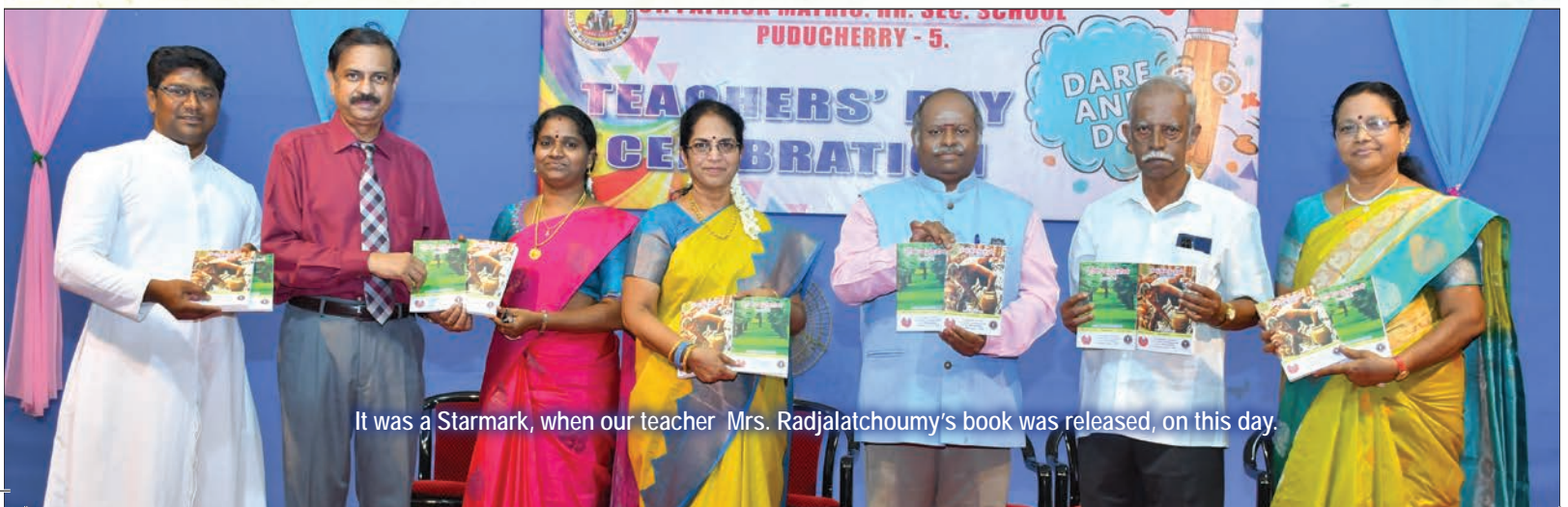
